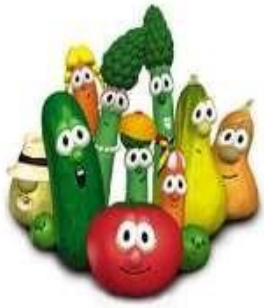


JUNIOR WORK HORTICULTURE CLASS 501
